Last month, the Lord answered our prayers by providing James with a location to set up a table where he can minister to people and distribute items such as tracts, books, tapes and CDs. What a great blessing this been! The table presence this set-up avails has given

him even more opportunities to interact with the people in our neighborhood. He sets up his table most afternoons in the parking lot of a little convenience store that is one block over from our home on the corner of Knox & 26th. This corner is riddled with gang members, drug dealers and lost youth from broken families who need Christ. With the store and a bus stop right there plenty of traffic crosses his path. This table ministry has proven very fruitful even in the short time that it has been in existence. It provides a great launching

ground for encouraging more in-depth time of conversation and the opportunity to invite people to our home for further study.

Two teenagers who are new believers have come to the house and spent time

studying the Word with James. Their plan is for that to be an ongoing time discipleship. The Lord also brought another young man over for an hour and fifteen minute study of John 1:1-15. This man is one of the dealers who opened up his heart to James. He has also had the opportunity to share lengthy,

complete gospel presentation with a number of others. We were both able to minister to a young girl, Kiara, who came to shovel our walkway over the Thanksgiving weekend. While she was there to shovel, we shared the gospel with her and answered many of her questions. She came back the following day and spent over an hour with us reading through John chapter 1.
